

2024 Putney Open Door Fund Scholarship Application Instructions

For Putney Student Travel Programs

Completed applications to the Putney Open Door Fund (PODF) must be received by mail at the address specified below *no later than February 15, 2024*. The Scholarship Application is accepted via mail only and is a separate process from the online application on the Putney Student Travel website. Applications will not be accepted online, via email or fax. Applications must arrive by the deadline with all requested application components in order to be considered. *Application Deposits are waived for PODF applicants*.

A complete application consists of:

- 1. 2024 Putney Open Door Fund Scholarship Application Form
- 2. 2024 Putney Student Travel Agreement Form
- 3. Applicant Statement consisting of:
 - The applicant's specific connection to Putney's programs and mission.
 - Demonstrating interest in the program destination or theme.
 - Demonstrating what the applicant hopes to gain from the experience.
 - Addressing what the applicant feels they will contribute to a program and group of peers.
- 4. Two completed Teacher Reference Forms. To maintain confidentiality, references should be placed in sealed envelopes with the teacher's signature across the seal.
- 5. Copy of parents' or guardians' most recent federal tax returns (fiscal year 2020 or 2021) and/or verification of non-taxable income (social security income, disability benefits, TANF, child support, etc.). Financial documentation from all contributing households is required.
- 6. Parent/Guardian statement explaining the household's financial obligations, need for financial support, and outlining the unique characteristics of the applicant that demonstrate how the student would benefit from and contribute to a Putney program. (If the applicant is financially emancipated or serves as head of household, this can be completed by the applicant.)

Post-Travel Scholar Evaluation

Our scholarship students' descriptions of their experiences are the most powerful tool we have for ensuring the health, growth and longevity of the Putney Open Door Fund. It's essential that our donors feel a direct connection to the students they fund. Testimonials from PODF participants play a crucial role in our ability to communicate the life-changing experience of educational travel on behalf of the fund, its board, and our donors. Therefore, it is essential that we receive detailed feedback from all scholarship recipients about their experiences during their programs. The PODF



requires, as a condition of receiving an award, that each scholarship applicant and the applicant's parent/guardian agree as follows:

If selected to receive a scholarship, The Putney Open Door Fund may use application information, photos of the applicant and applicant correspondence for scholar profiles and, in future fundraising materials.

Scholarship recipients will submit an evaluation of their program and experience for review by the PODF within 15 days of the end of their summer program.
